Chairman Dwight Purvis called the work session to order.

Board reviewed Mr. Cronin's information on the personnel manual.

Daniel Barber – Road/Landfill Superintendent:

- Discussed spraying county roads. Board agreed that their comfort level is with mowing. Mr. Dwight asked for additional information on the product.
- Landfill truck being repaired by Mr. Bullard will hopefully be ready tomorrow. Mr. Bullard did say there was an issue with 3rd gear. Approximate cost at this point is around \$2500 up from original quote of \$2300. Mr. Barber stated that there was a mention of a wheel bearing issue, but he wants the truck back, if the truck has a wheel bearing issue, the road department will make the repair.
- Landfill is now running two trucks to haul collection site trailers. Mr. Barber believes that
 in a few days it will be obvious that two trucks are running and we should have plenty of
 empty trailers. Once trailers are pulled each day, all employees will be onsite at the
 landfill.
- The beaver contractor has killed 14 beavers so far. As Mr. Browning makes the kills, sends documentation to Mr. Barber's phone, showing the location and number of beavers

<u>District 3 – Grading</u>: Commissioner Lane requested that grading be suspended in district 3 until after we have some rain.

Southern Georgia Executive Committee of Local Chief Elected Officials, board discussed an appointee for this advisory council. Commissioner Lindsey Parrish agreed to be appointed.

Stray Dog Issue: Ms. Miley from J C Abbott Road, Adel, Georgia, discussed a recent issue with her goats being killed. Dogs in the area were seen in the pen with the goats. She stated that she had a good fence to prevent dogs or other animals having access to the goats. She was concerned of the number of dogs in the area. A deputy did came out to the scene but stated that there was nothing that he could do. Requested something be done to hold owners accountable.
