As you are probably aware there was an accident at Antioch Road and Old Union Road approximately 3 weeks ago. Due to a person not stopping at the stop sign someone lost their life.

I have eye witnessed people crossing that intersection on Old Union Rd that didn't even slow down, let alone come to a rolling stop. Not just one time but many. I met with Brent Lupo, DOT, District 4/Traffic Operation, District Signal Manager at the intersection last week. He was early to the meeting, while he was waiting he also witnessed someone running the stop sign. While Commissioner Rowe (in full uniform), Mr. Lupo and I were discussing the best plan to enhance the safety of the intersection, a truck rolled right past the stop sign without stopping.

The intersection is properly marked, rumble strips are down, etc. Mr. Lupo suggested that the 24 inch white stop bar be painted on Old Union. Peek has done that. He also suggested that we put flashing "STOP AHEAD" signs on Old Union with flashing "STOP" signs too. On Antioch Road, he suggested we put up flashing "Dangerous Intersection" signs. Mr. Lupo sent me a list of vendors that sell and install the signs we need. These signs are solar powered.

To date I only have two replies from all the vendors I sent requests to.
