Chairman Purvis called the meeting to order.

Vicki Parrish gave the Invocation.

Commission Board led the pledge to the flag.

MINUTES: Commissioner Robinson moved to approve the July 3, 2017 Work and Regular Session meeting minutes, second Commissioner Rowe. Motion carried, 5 yes votes.

FY 2017-2018 Budget: There was no one present for a public hearing as advertised in the Adel News-Tribune.

OLD UNION & ANTIOCH ROAD INTERSECTION: Commissioner Parrish moved to accept the quote from American Lighting & Signalization, Inc. \$30,000.34, for the intersection enhancements at Old Union and Antioch Road, second Commissioner Rowe. Motion carried unanimously.

PROBATE JUDGE CHASE DAUGHTREY / PART-TIME EMPLOYEE: Commissioner Robinson moved to allow budget funds be included to hire an additional part-time person in the Probate court per Judge Chase Daughtrey's request, second Commissioner Rowe. Motion carried, 5 yes votes.

TRANSIT VEHICLES –SURPLUS INVENTORY: No action taken.

CATASTROPHIC INMATE MEDICAL APPLICATION: Commissioner Lane made the motion to approve the Catastrophic Inmate Medical Policy application and authorize the Chairman's endorsement on the same, 10,676.25, second Commissioner Robinson. Motion carried.

TAX COMMISSIONER – CITY OF ADEL, TAX COLLECTION AGREEMENT: Commissioner Rowe moved to accept the City of Adel Tax Collection Agreement and authorize the Chair's endorsement on the same, second Commissioner Robinson. Motion carried unanimously.

Tax Commissioner, Tonya McConnell, presented the agreement for adoption. The agreement states that Ms. McConnell will pay Cook County \$1500 annually for her additional duties and responsibilities as required for the assessment of the collection of City of Adel taxes.

RAILROAD CROSSING REPAIRS: Commissioner Rowe moved to contract with Omni Track for the repairs to the following county railroad crossings, (Greggs Road, Old Union, Rountree Bridge and Reed Bingham), maximum cost \$4000, second Commissioner Parrish. Motion carried unanimously.

ZONING ORDINANCE – RVs and MOTORHOMES MORATORIUM: Commissioner Robinson moved to lift the moratorium on zoning enforcement for temporary residency requirement for RV's and Motorhomes, second Commissioner Rowe. Motion carried, 5 yes votes.

Commissioner Lane moved to adjourn the meeting, second Commissioner Robinson. Motion carried unanimously.
