Chairman Dwight Purvis called the work session to order.

FY2015-2016 Audit - Pat Ashley, Meeks CPA, presented the FY2015-16 county audit. Audit shows the county with an increased fund balance of 5.1 million (up from 3.1 million last audit). Mr. Ashley remarked that compared to most counties (that he is familiar with) our fund balance level is outstanding.

T-SPLOST MEETING - GDOT meeting August 11th regarding the T-Splost Regional Transportation Roundtable. Board reviewed the list presented.

Service Delivery Strategy Meeting - ACCG Training for the Service Delivery Strategy Planning, Tuesday, August 29, 2017, Applying County.

2017 LMIG Striping List – Project listing for the 2017 LMIG Striping List, \$138,140.00. County Administrator, Faye Hughes, recommended the county do all roads listed.

2018 LMIG -Resurfacing Projects – Scores from Arrow Engineering: Board reviewed Arrow Engineering's list of roads that are scheduled to be resurfaced. Resurfacing scores were done by Arrow Engineering. \$546,360 resurfacing for roads that score the highest in need. Total LMIG for 2018 \$640,689.56. Additional $\frac{3}{4}$ in district 4, McConnell Bridge Road or County Farm Road.

Hutchison Parrish Road (Adel City Limits to Coxstill Raod and Rowan Road to Hwy 76) were scored for resurfacing but were left off the listing from Arrow Engineering.

Courthouse Renovations – Doors: Board reviewed an invoice from Kelly Construction Co. for repairing doors and hanging new doors, \$2,250. Request for a new door and repairs to other doors initiated from Judge Daughtrey, Probate Court. There were also some doors in the Superior Court offices that were repaired..

Tift County Hospital Authority Agreement – Board reviewed final version of the Intergovernmental Agreement with Tift County Hospital Authority. Building permits will not be waived.

City of Cecil Request: City of Cecil has requested aid, they are in need of a backhoe and operator. The county attorney will prepare a liability waiver for work to be done.

Kyle Breeden – Former Member of Cecil VFD: Mr. Breeden discussed issues within the fire departments and recommendations to improve departments.

Commissioner Robinson moved to adjourn work session, second Commissioner Rowe. Motion carried, 5 yes votes.
