Chairman Dwight Purvis called the work session to order.

<u>Personnel Policies and Procedures:</u> Board reviewed proposed updates in the Personnel Policies and Procedures.

<u>Recreation Board Members:</u> Chad Bush, Member-Recreation Board and Michael Folsom, Recreation Director, spoke to the board regarding the new recreation development. Development of the new recreation facility will begin January 1, 2018.

Larry Arnold and Tax Assessors' Board: Larry Arnold, Chief Appraiser, presented a request for additional staff member that would serve as a personal property appraiser.

<u>Daniel Barber – Road Department:</u> Mr. Barber presented his road work detail. He also made a request to rent a mini excavator for one month, \$3000, to aid the post hurricane clean up. There was no motion made but the board agreed that a mini excavator was needed.

<u>Tree Removal</u>: The board discussed the county's responsibility of moving trees that have fallen across a ditch fence onto the county road. The county attorney (later by email) advised that county responsibility is to remove the tree off the county right of way and the property owner would be responsible for removing the tree off his property.

In some cases, the board discussed that the road department could remove the trees off the right of way by reaching with the arm of the excavator (with no equipment entering private property).

<u>Striping Bids</u>: Bids were opened for the 32.735 miles of striping from the 2017 LMIG Striping Project.
