Vice-Chairman Randy Lane called the meeting to order.

Faye Hughes gave the invocation.

The Commission Board led the Pledge to the American Flag.

MINUTES: Commissioner Michael Dinnerman moved to adopt minutes from February 2, 2015 Work Session and Regular Session, second Commissioner Purvis. Motion carried unanimously.

DFCS BOARD REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING: Commissioner Purvis made the motion to increase the Department of Family & Children Services' FY 2015 Budget by an additional \$5000.00, second Commissioner Robinson, 4 yes votes.

SAFER GRANT: Commissioner Purvis moved to ratify the decision to apply for the Staffing for Adequate Fire & Emergency Response (SAFER) grant. (Grant will fund 2 full time fire fighter positions two years and require the county to fund the positions for the third year), second Commissioner Randy Lane.

After a lengthy discussion, Commissioner Randy Lane withdrew his second; the motion died for the lack of a second.

JOB DESCRIPTIONS: Commissioner Purvis made the motion to adopt the job descriptions prepared by Condrey & Associates during the salary study, August 2011, second Commissioner Robinson, 4 yes votes.

Job description for an equipment operator will have "pre-trip inspection required" added.

BOARD OF ELECTIONS APPOINTMENT – MARY SUE WARD: Commissioner Purvis moved to appoint Ms. Mary Sue Ward to the Board of Elections & Registrations, to fill the unexpired term of Brian Harrell, second Commissioner Dinnerman. Motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Ward's term will be March 2015- December 2016.

TRACTOR BIDS: Commissioner Purvis made the motion to have the county administrator prepare specs for bid packets to replace the 7130 John Deere tractor, second Commissioner Robinson, 4 yes votes.

DRIVEWAY REPAIRS: Commissioner Dinnerman made the motion for the road department to haul millings/rock purchased by a property owner to repair driveways on county right of way (property owners will pay for the expense - upgrade from soil to millings/rock), second Commissioner Purvis. Motion carried unanimously.

GEORGIA STATE PATROL – RADARS: Commissioner Dinnerman made the motion to purchase 4 radars for the Georgia State Patrol, quote of \$11,898.00 from Stalker Radar, second Commissioner Robinson. Motion carried with 4 yes votes.
