#### A. Please see the following construction estimates for the 2015 LMIG:

Airport Square	\$334,985.00
Nell Purvis and McConnell Bridge Intersection	\$62,844.00
McConnell Bridge and Old Union Intersection	\$57,904.00
Total	<b>\$455,733.00</b>

The estimates above are based on all of the work being bid out and constructed by others.

If we construct Airport Square with Cook County personnel and equipment there will be substantial savings.

I expect that Airport Square could be constructed for around \$200,000.00 using Cook County forces. If so, this would allow us to repair the two intersections I have listed as well. My estimate numbers are a little high on the intersections, so I expect that I could value engineer the work as needed to get all three projects built with the money allocated by GDOT.
