- A. Probate Judge, Chase Daughtrey
  - Request for additional staff
  
- B. Chris Davis, Building/Zoning Administrator
  - Courthouse Air Condition replacement, 2 ton unit \$3,482 plus cost of crane to remove old unit
  - Administrative Building signage
  
- C. Rusty McCranie, Road Department
  - International Dump truck – (formerly at landfill), issue with quote
  - Sweeper purchase – road department will check for surplus sweepers
  - Truck specifications for landfill truck (truck that pulls green boxes) board was presented the work detail
  
- D. County Administrator advised that Elm Street does belong to Cook County and the county would reimburse the City of Sparks for full cost of striping, \$7,048.
  
- E. Nick Griffin – Pond Easement
  - Project to dig pond began in 2014, EPD has concerns of location near a major highway. Faye advised the board that the road department will need to coordinate work schedule in order to complete project.
  
- F. Brandon Rutland, Lenox VFD
  - Radio communication not adequate to reach 911 from north end of the county
  - Concern about fire vehicles leaving the county. Board instructed Faye to send a Memo instructing first responders (fire volunteers) that they are prohibited from leaving the county; and, explain if they are answering a fire call they aren't covered by worker's comp.
  - Send out a request for recommendations to resolve the radio issue - Hasty's RCE and John McGlaglin
