Commissioner Michael Dinnerman called the work session to order and the Board met on the following items:

Landfill Fees for John Cox: Mr. John Cox requested the Board waive landfill charges in the amount of \$412.80, fees incurred disposing of his home that was destroyed by fire.

John Crosby Road: Additional work needed on the dam on John Crosby Road to protect the integrity of the dam and the county road during heavy rain fall. Work done on the property will be done with an easement from the property owner.

County Line Church : Church members from County Line Church have requested that the road department replace a driveway pipe going into the cemetery on church property, the church will be responsible for the cost of the pipe. Work on the church property will be done with an easement.

Old Coffee Road Bridge Repairs: Southern Concrete's estimate for repairs to Old Coffee Road Bridge at Futch's Ferry, \$56,195.00.

Pest Control Bids: Bids will be taken for pest control services for county buildings, agreement will be for 3 years and include 2 inspections for termites annually with written documentation of the inspections.

Christmas Holidays: An elected official requested the Board's consideration of extending the Christmas Holiday schedule through Friday, December 26th.

DNR Decoy Deer: Chairman Dinnerman requested the Board's consideration in providing the DNR with a decoy deer, approximately \$1200-1500; the decoy will be purchased for Cook County and will not follow the job assignment for the DNR officer.

South Georgia Community Service Board appointment was discussed, Commissioner Randy Lane agreed to serve on the service board.

Commissioner Randy Lane requested the road department remove a tree on Evergreen Church Road, discussed the issue of 911 responding to calls for blocked roadways. Commissioner Randy Lane also requested a fire truck for the Fall Festival at Springhead Baptist Church on November 1, 2014.

LMIG Projects: Chairman Dinnerman and Commissioner Jeff Lane discussed Airport Square being added to the LMIG projects. Faye Hughes, County Administrator, discussed a grant that could provide funding for the Morrison Creek area, which may include some of the area on Airport Square.
