Chairman Purvis called the work session to order.

Motorgrader Bids were opened by County Administrator, Faye Hughes. Flint Equipment Co. 270G JD Motograder, \$201,0000, 5 year/7500 hour guaranteed buyback of \$100,000, final costs \$101,000; Yancey Bros. 12 M3 Caterpillar Motorgrader, \$219,855, with no buy back guarantee.

Daniel Barber – Road/Landfill Superintendent: Mr. Barber presented the road work detail. He presented a request from New Hope Church for 4-5 load of topsoil, the board could not grant the request for work on private property.

Road and Landfill Transfers – Daniel Barber requested for the employee that was already scheduled to transfer to the landfill be permitted to do so. The transfer in question was agreed upon prior to the board freezing lateral moves between road and landfill departments. The board agreed to allow the lateral move since Mr. Barber had already extended the job offer to the employee.
