Opioid Litigation: Danny Studstill and Daniel Connell spoke to the board regarding the Opioid Litigation. Mr. Studstill and Mr. Connell feel that it would be beneficial for the county to enter into the litigation.

Daniel Barber – Road Superintendent presented his department's road work detail

Keith Walker, Chief, Chaserville VFD: Mr. Walker discussed equipment needs for the Chaserville Department. Chief Walker stated that due to the lack of equipment in the department, he was unsure of the results from the recent ISO testing.

Commissioners will reach out to their district departments to request equipment or gear that is extra or if any departments have equipment that belongs to Chaserville.

Barneyville Road Resurfacing – From Larry Sanders - In short, we can multiply the length of road in miles by \$113,670.30 for the areas that need substantial patching to get our budget number. Based on the cost of the Massee Post Road resurfacing project we completed last year, the portions of Barneyville that are in disrepair are very similar in size and amount of patching needed. There is approximately 7.85 miles that would need substantial patching. 7.85\*(113,670.30) = \$892,311.86
