According to his calculations, dump trucks the size of our county trucks are would be required to haul 4200 loads. His department's deadlines with FEMA projects in order to no jeopardize funding will prohibit our participation other than an occasional truck and driver or motorgrader and driver being able to assist.

RFP's for EMS Services:

Grady EMS – Proposed \$300,000 annually for a 5 year contract.

Gold Star EMS – Proposed \$35,000 monthly 1st year; \$36,000 monthly, second year; \$37,500, third year; \$38,500 fourth year; and, \$39,500 fifth year.
