Chairman Robinson called the work session to order.

Daniel Baber – Road/Landfill Superintendent: Mr. Barber presented his road work detail. From Mr. Barber's meeting with City of Adel officials, he discussed the new recreation area build on Hwy 37. Mr. Barber explained that the scope of work at the new recreation field is more work than county equipment can perform. According to Mr. Barber's calculations, dump trucks the size of our county trucks would be required to haul 4200 loads. The deadline to complete FEMA projects is December 31, 2018 or our reimbursement will be jeopardized. Mr. Barber told the board we could occasionally assist the city with a truck and driver or motorgrader and operator.

RFP's for EMS Services:

Grady EMS – Proposed \$300,000 annually for a 5 year contract.

Gold Star EMS – Proposed \$35,000 monthly 1st year; \$36,000 monthly, second year; \$37,500, third year; \$38,500 fourth year; and, \$39,500 fifth year.

Chase Daughtrey, Probate Judge, request for vehicle was presented. The board reviewed three bids from Cook County Ford – new 2018 Ford F150 Crew Cab Truck \$23,859.15, new 2018 Ford Explorer base \$25,620.00 and used 2014 Ford Explorer \$23,976.00.

911 Salary Changes – County Administrator, Faye Hughes, presented information regarding salary increases for 911 operators.

Sheriff Doug Hanks discussed purchasing a new K-9 dog, cost \$6500.00.
