Daniel Baber – Road/Landfill Superintendent: Mr. Barber presented his road work detail. He also presented a request for grading private lanes off Old Coffee Road and Pine Valley Road. County Administrator, Faye Hughes, read the private property policy from the minutes of January 17, 1989. And, followed with a listing of 33 private lanes in Cook County. She furthered advised the board there were other issues to be considered before reaching a decision to scrap the private lanes/drives.

Southeast Cook VFD - John McLaglin, Chief-Southeast Cook VFD, presented a request for assistance in picking up a tank and chassis from Georgia Forestry Unit, Macon.

Opioid Litigation - The board reviewed an update on the pending opioid litigation.
