As I have explained before, when our portion of the LMIG Projects go over the 30% the County is required to fund, the following LMIG can be used to offset the cost. The 2019 LMIG is exactly that a request to fund the excessive cost from 2018.

The bid was \$1,528,442.42 448,482.69 LMIG 2018 66,266.37 Lenox Street <u>134,544.81 30% Match</u> 879,148.55 Balance 456,820.25 LMIG 2019 <u>137,046.08 30% Match</u> 285,281.42 Balance

This calculation shows the County has already expended enough funds to match 2020 and 2021 10% match.

We still have to decide the roads that are your priority for 2019. You have to decide which roads are a priority in order to have them listed for future projects. As soon as, Larry Sanders finishes grading the additional roads you will be able to make that decision. Therefore; we will continue the selection process.

Applying for the funding this way allows us to get our application in sooner, it does not prohibit our prioritizing the roads that are currently being graded and letting bids. Remember your T-SPLOST funds will start coming in January.
