

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

The Cook County Emergency Management Agency (EMA), in cooperation with the Southern Georgia Regional Commission (SGRC), invites the public to attend a Joint Public Hearing to review the Cook County and Cities of Adel, Cecil, Lenox and Sparks Hazard Mitigation Plan Update and provide an opportunity for public comment. The plan update has been developed in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, which requires local governments to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan addressing natural hazards as a condition of receiving future federal disaster assistance.
