To Enact a Curfew for a Local and State Declared State of Emergency

Whereas: Cook County, Georgia may experience a tropical storm and hurricane force winds and rain from Hurricane Michael Wednesday, October 10, 2018.

Whereas: There may be loss of life and and other citizens injured.

Whereas: Homes and business may experience extensive damage.

Whereas: Personal effects and property of those affected may be scattered about the affected areas.

Whereas: The Board of Commissioners, by request acting on behalf of the City Councils of the City of Adel, Town of Cecil, Town of Lenox and Town of Sparks and the unincorporated areas of Cook County seek to prevent and protect the property of the citizens of Cook County affected by this weather event,

Now Therefore Be It Known and So Resolved: The Cook County Board of Commissioners does hereby enact a curfew from 7:00 pm, October 10th, 2018 until 1:00 am October 11th, 2018 within the affected damaged areas throughout Cook County.

Further Resolved: the Sheriff of Cook County shall have the right to enforce such curfew.
