As you might already know, the Aging Advisory Council is essential to the success of the Southern Georgia Regional Commission's Area Agency on Aging. The Aging Advisory Council assists with the development of the area plan for aging programs, advocates for the interests of older individuals, and facilitates coordination of services for the elderly in the eighteen-county area. The Aging Advisory Council consists of 36 members, with each county and its largest municipality represented.

The terms of the current members of the Aging Advisory Council will expire on June 30, 2019.
