Chairman Parrish called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Jeff Lane gave the invocation and the pledge was led by the Commission.

<u>MINUTES</u>: Commissioner Robinson made the motion to approve March 4th meeting minutes, second Commissioner Rowe. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>AIR EVAC LIFE TEAM / AirMedCare</u> – Peggy Rhodes and Greg Dampier: Ms. Rhodes and Mr. Dampier spoke to the Commission about Air Evac Life Team that is now servicing the entire County.

2019 CATERPILLAR M318F WHEEL EXCAVATOR – ACCG RESOLUTION AND LEASE AGREEMENT: Commissioner Rowe moved to accept the terms of the Leasing Proposal from ACCG / BB&T, adopt the Resolution Authorizing Execution of the Lease Purchase Agreement for the purchase of the 2019 Caterpillar M318F Wheel Excavator, \$284,607.00 (including the echo head), second Commissioner Lane. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Board.

<u>BUILDING & ZONING ROOFING REPAIR/REPLACEMENT PERMITS:</u> Commissioner Purvis moved to approve adding a Roof Repair/Replacement Permit to the schedule of required permits to be issued and inspected by the Cook County Building/Zoning Department, second Commissioner Rowe. Motion carried, 5 yes votes.

<u>WIREGRASS TECHNICAL COLLEGE – LEASE AGREEMENT</u>: Commissioner Lane moved to approve the Rental Agreement Between the Cook County Board of Commissioners and State Properties Commission and Technical College System of Georgia for \$812.25 per month and \$15,000 for insurance reimbursement, repair and routine maintenance. Second Commissioner Robinson. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>SOUTH GEORGIA AREA AGENCY ON AGING – FY 2020 CONTRACT FOR SERVICES:</u> Commissioner Purvis moved to accept the FY2020 Area Agency on Aging Contract for home delivered and congregate meals, second Commissioner Robinson. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Board.

<u>WIREGRASS TECHNICAL COLLEGE – DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE COMMUNITY OFFICER</u> <u>OF POLICING SERVICES: SCHOOL VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM</u>: Commissioner Rowe made the motion to approve funding for matching grant funds for the School Violence Prevention Program Grant, \$10,000, (for additonal security camears for Wiregrass Campus), second Commissioner Purvis. Motion carried, 5 yes votes. <u>EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE RENEWAL:</u> Commissioner Robinson moved to accept Partner's Benefit Group's recommendation for the renewal of employee health insurance benefits with the Blue Cross Blue Shield, ACCG pool, with a 16.9% increase. Second Commissioner Rowe. Motion carried unanimously.

New premium per employee \$686.07 (\$99.25 increase per month per employee). Annual increase to impact the County, \$114,336, the County will absorb increase.

Dental, Vision, and Basic Life will move to Principal with a reduction in premiums and a two-year rate guarantee; STD and LTD will remain with Principal.

<u>VFD FIRE TRUCK PURCHASE</u> – Commissioner Lane moved to approve purchasing the following vehicles: 1998 Ferrara Freightline Pumper \$55,000, 1997 E-One International-Pumper \$55,000 and 2000 E-One International Commercial – Pumper \$65,000, from Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus, with the condition that the purchase price not exceed \$175,000.00. Second Commissioner Purvis. Motion carried, 5 yes votes. Puchase of the 3 trucks was finalized at \$175,000.

With all business was concluded, Commissioner Lane moved to adjourn the meeting, Commissioner Purvis made the second. Motion carried.
