2. FEMA Projects – Cook County has been given another extension on the FEMA projects there are still 14 of the 29 roads that have not been repaired as specified by FEMA. This final extension is through December 26, 2019.

Due to the additional work being request in individual districts outside of every day maintenance, I am requesting either more people be hired to do the FEMA projects or mandate that FEMA projects only be done on Fridays and that all employees be required to work Fridays.

Currently, during the week 17 of the 20 people in the Road Dept are dedicated to a specific job. That leaves 3 people as alternates to replace signs, flag, assist in the shop as needed, and as fill-ins when someone is out.

People must be pulled away from every day maintenance for special projects, pipe installation and to finish up the FEMA projects. It might not take very long to finish the FEMA projects but unless time is dedicated specifically to those projects, it cannot be done. We have been given two extensions to date, this is the third.

I am asking the Board to consider dedicating Fridays to FEMA projects unless there is an emergency and mandating that Road Department employees be required to work.
