Dear Commissioner Purvis,

It was great seeing you at the Cook County Comprehensive Plan workshop. I'm impressed that you remembered me and the project I'm working on within your county.

I wanted to let you know that I followed up on that area we were talking about – the trailer park near Barneyville Road, and Massee Post Road (please see enclosed, "Map 1"). I verified that it is, in fact, within the target area for our project. We would be able to provide 50% reimbursement for septic tank pump-outs, repairs and replacements. There are conditions to the offer, to include the use of Georgia-certified operators, and for repairs/replacements a Department of Public Health permit must be obtained before work commences.

Please let me know if this was what you had in mind, and if you have ideas on how to connect with residents in this area. We still have several more repairs/replacements/pump-outs that we are contractually obligated with the Georgia Environmental Protection Division to accomplish, and there's time and money remaining.

Also, as we discussed, I'm looking for candidate project areas for our next grant proposal. Within Cook County there are two waterbodies impaired for Fecal Coliform due to Nonpoint Source Pollution. These are Morrison Creek, and Bear Creek (please see enclosed, "Map 2", red-indicated waterbodies).




