The minutes of the July 31, 2019, called meeting were presented for adoption. ON MOTION FROM TED HOLT AND SECOND FROM DALE HORNE, MINUTES OF JULY 31, 2019 WERE ACCEPTED WITH ALL IN FAVOR.

Chairman Brent Dixon asked Jerry Connell to provide information on the following items:

- Runway construction update: On time and under budget. Savings of \$114,000 on filter fabric and grading work to be used for runway edge striping and shoulder rehabilitation on 5/23. Lighting to be started week of January 13.
 Project completion due March 16.
- <u>Fencing design update:</u> Passero Associates will have a preliminary perimeter fence design ready to review on January 16. GDOT providing funds for design and phase 1.
- <u>Hangar update revenue, waiting list, expansion:</u> Hangar receipts for 2019 were \$58,615. There are 10 aircraft on the waiting list for hangars. Passero Associates are working on a proposal for 10 additional T-hangars.
- Gas pump issues and replacement request: Fuel account balance is \$32,094.53. Inventory AVGAS = 2943 gals. JET A = 2400 gals. Jerry reported problems with the existing gas kiosk. A quote to replace the old M3000 kiosk with a new M4000 was reviewed. ON MOTION FROM TED HOLT AND SECOND FROM DALE HORNE, THE QUOTE FROM L&T FOR PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF THE M4000 FUEL KIOSK WAS APPROVED WITH ALL IN FAVOR.


