According to GDOT correspondence, the 2020 LMIG funds for Cook County will be in the amount of \$500,910.00. Faye's email to me stated that the 2020 LMIG would be reimbursing our General Fund for resurfacing projects already completed.

In speaking with Shannon Bradford, District State Aid Coordinator, I asked about using our resurfacing of 7.5 miles of Barneyville Road that was completed in 2019. He advised that we could use this project in our application for the 2020 LMIG. And, that this one project would be sufficient since the contract was \$1,923,239.49 for the project, exceeding the LMIG money for 2020.
