- 2003 Volvo axles, project cost of Lewis Machine Shop \$3,925 for new axle bracket; to repair axle brackets \$1,450. Chairman Lane suggested ordering new brackets \$1,000 per wheel.
- Scott Shealey, Triple S Pallet Co., has offered saw dust to be installed on the roads in the landfill.
- Shaw Lane, Forte Road, Billy Browning Road, installing lime rock 14 loads, \$4750. Rountree Construction, rock will be stock piled at the Southeast Cook VFD.
- Eric McDaniel proposal to change out the shop lights for LED lighting, approximate cost \$2600.

Johnny West, Fire Chief, requesting purchase of the extrication equipment, \$7000. Mr. West stated there were several surplus vehicles and those funds could be applied to the cost. He feels there is definitely a need for the equipment, 9 car accidents in 2019 that the equipment was used (City of Adel's equipment). Mr. West will get with County Administrator, Faye Hughes, to further discuss funding.

Ms. Renee Petty, 250 River Trace Road, Hahira, Georgia, brought a complaint to the Board regarding her neighbors shooting skeet several days a week, several hours at a time, all hours of the day. She stated the situation has become very stressful for her and her children. Ms. Petty was informed that Cook County does not have a noise ordinance. Jess Permenter, Building/Zoning Administrator, will check into what can be done to assist Ms. Petty.

Commissioner Rowe asked that the public be informed that he was in Washington, D.C. attending a conference. While in Washington, he will be visiting Rep. Austin Scott and Agriculture Secretary Sonny Perdue and presenting gifts to them on behalf of Cook County.
