COOK COUNTY 4-H COVID-19 ACCOMPLISHMENTS, REACH AND IMPACT



CREATING A DESIGN FOR BADGES TO SUPPORT FRONTLINERS March 20, 2020

Cook 4-H challenged youth to create a design and upload it to the comment section on Facebook. The winning designs were used as badges given out to hospitals/health care professionals. Badge post reach **2,969**; engagement **305**; youth participation **10** with multiple entries per youth; total badges made and donated to various frontliners **100**.

COOK COUNTY 4-H OFFERS OFFLINE KNOWLEDGE April 2, 2020

Cook 4-H shared **100 bags** filled with **educational resources** as a **community service project called COOK Books** (*Cook 4-H Offers Offline Knowledge*). Resources donated by *Mrs. Kristy Wilmot*, parent of our home schooled 4-H'er. **Over 100 brand new books** (coloring books, puzzles, word search, storybooks) were included in our educational packets, activity sheets with answer keys from the Georgia Foundation for Agriculture and 4-H Stem Labs. Healthy living coloring pages created by Cook 4-H agent were also included. Our Facebook post reached **3,642** people, had **435** engagements and **23** shares.

COOK COUNTY 4-H COLLABORATES WITH COOK COUNTY FAMILY CONNECTION IN COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT (200 families reached) *May 20, 2020*

Cook 4-H once again offered COOK Books (Cook 4-H Offers Offline Knowledge) where we shared 200 bags filled with healthy living educational resources to include Georgia 4-H Friends Magazines as well as worksheets from MyPlate Kid's Place, Georgia School Nutrition Program, and UGA SNAP-Ed to name a few. Healthy snacks were also included in these healthy living packets made possible by our donors Kellie Day and Lee Allen. Cook County Family Connection supplied the first 100 families with bags of fruits and boxes of food. We loaded every vehicle with thirty pounds of canned foods, peanut butter, apples, oranges and bananas. Our Facebook post reached 6,705 people and had 603 engagements.
