Hope you all are having a wonderful week!

We just wanted to take a moment and remind you that we have not received your 2021 Employee Safety Grant Application yet. **Do not leave cash sitting on the table!!** The Board of Trustees of the ACCG – Group Self-Insurance Workers' Compensation Fund created the Employee Safety Grant Program to provide financial assistance to members for the purpose of reducing employees' injuries through additional training, equipment, and services. There is **\$500,000** available to eligible Fund members in 2021. Those who are eligible are active members as of the time of the distribution who have earned the 2021 Safety Discount and are current on their premiums; your organization is eligible!

Applications will be accepted until **August 31, 2021**, and all purchases must be made by December 1, 2021. Examples of previously approved requests includes: personal protective equipment, body armor, fire department turnout gear or washers/dryers for gear, ergo equipment, first aid equipment such as AEDs, and fees for safety-related courses.

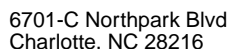
