Commissioner Parrish moved to adopt the minutes as presented. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Rowe. Motion carried, with all in favor.

The Board of Commissioners decided the Windstream Broadband Townhall meeting would be held at the Cook County Extension office on Tuesday November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, at 5 P.M.

Commissioner Parrish made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Lane to accept the Tim Cannington Construction, Inc. proposal, in the amount of \$48,900.00, for the Barneyville Rd. at Big Branch culvert repairs project. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Rowe made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Parrish to adopt a Resolution that the Board of Commissioners desire to initiate the process outlined in the Transportation Investment Act of 2010 for the voters of the Southern Georgia Region to consider continued imposition of a one cent sales tax (TSPLOST) for the purposes of funding transportation infrastructure improvements in the region. Motion carried unanimously.

The CDBG 2022 award will be presented to Cook County at the DCA Awards Recognition Event on October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at 1P.M. in Douglas Ga. Chairman Purvis and Commissioner Rowe agreed to attend the event and accept the award on behalf of Cook County.

With all business concluded, Commissioner Rowe moved to adjourn the meeting, motion was seconded by Commissioner Parrish. Motion carried.
